**ORDER**

Sri.Pradeep.V has filed an OA before the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal challenging the order of DTE (Annexure A9). Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal has disposed of the case by pronouncing that if the applicant has a case for the grant of selection grade, he may move the Government by filing a representation along with a copy of the order of the Court within one month and the Government will consider and pass orders on it after affording an opportunity of being heard.

As ordered by the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, the incumbent was heard by the Deputy Secretary on 11.11.2015.

The incumbent had put in four years and nine months service as Lecturer in MES College from 1/9/1997 to 19/6/2002. He joined service at Government Engineering College, Kozhikode on 20/6/2002 as Lecturer. He was sanctioned Senior Scale in consideration of his previous experience in MES college, as on the date of declaration of his probation on 20/6/2004 in view of para 3.11 of Go(P) 68/2000/H.Edn dt 18/5/2000.

He was sanctioned Selection Grade scale w.e.f 20/6/2009. His claim is to consider his teaching experience of nine months and two years and four months industrial experience also for placement in Selection Grade scale w.e.f 20.5.2006. His request is based on para 3.11(Sl.Nos 1, 2 and 3) of GO(P)68/2000/H.Edn.dt 18.5.2000.

In fact the incumbent has already been granted the benefit of placement in Senior grade scale. He cannot claim further benefit in the Selection Grade Scale also. The oblique symbol(/) shown between Senior and Selection under the above para of the above Government order is used to show alternative, i.e. either in Senior or Selection Grade. If it meant both, it would have been shown as both Senior and Selection grade. Therefore the request of the incumbent for double claim is invalid and hereby rejected.

The directions of the Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal in the order read above is thus complied with as aforesaid.
